## COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

*William Chase, D.D.S., '72 Past President, Michigan Dental Association* 



Dr. William Chase is a remarkable individual whose life story is woven with threads of philanthropy, leadership, and compassion. Born and raised amidst the orchards of Adrian, Michigan, he inherited a spirit of resilience from his upbringing. Growing up in a family of entrepreneurs and artists with an identical twin brother, Chase learned early on the value of blending business with creativity.

The path to his dental career was with its challenges. Amidst the trials of family illness, Chase's determination to pursue his dreams

remained unyielding. After a detour to assist his family, he found himself enrolled in Adrian College, eventually earning a seat in the Dental Class of 1972 at the University of Detroit.

Throughout his career, Chase has exemplified the true essence of service. From his early days volunteering with the Detroit Dental Clinic Club to his transformative experiences treating refugees in Palawan, he has tirelessly dedicated himself to humanitarian causes. Over a span of 25 years, and 13 missions, Chase selflessly provided dental care to thousands, often funding these endeavors himself.

Although many of Chase's volunteer and humanitarian efforts took him overseas where he treated over 10k patients, he has spent a considerable amount of time serving in the States. He has held several leadership positions within organized dentistry, including having been President of the Michigan Dental Association. The organization that seems closest to Chase's heart is Rotary International, of which he has been a proud member and recognized leader for the past 50 years. He remains involved in the club and spends much of his time teaching leadership skills to other Rotarians.

Chase is also a champion for diversity, equity, and inclusion. He encourages others to understand and appreciate different cultures and explains that the more we understand about our differences, values and orientations, the more we grow to accept them and make decisions based in facts, not emotions.

Chase's wisdom is as profound as his actions. Encouraging others to seize opportunities and embrace change, he embodies a philosophy of fearless living.

The custom of wearing academic gowns, caps and hoods dates back to the 12<sup>th</sup> century and likely had its inception in France, where the wearing of the cap and gown marked the formal admission of the "Licentiate" to the body of masters. The cold buildings of medieval times, in which the masters were obliged to teach, required caps and hoods which naturally were patterned after the prevailing dress of the times. Since a large number of scholars were clerics, the robes resembled the monks' dress. The hoods were fashioned after the monks' cowl and were attached to the gown so that they might be drawn over the head. Later, when the hood was displaced by the skull cap as a head covering, it was made separately from the gown. The skull cap evolved into a pointed cap which is evidenced today in the mortar board cap with its tassel.

Considering the development described above, it is natural that there would be a great variety of styles and usage. In order to maintain uniformity, an *Intercollegiate Code for Academic Costumes* has been adopted by most leading institutions of learning. As a result, the gowns and hoods of this country are a badge of learning, symbolic of the degree attained.

This code calls for three types of gowns: the Bachelor's, Master's and Doctor's. The Bachelor's gown is made with an open or closed front with long pointed sleeves. The Master's gown is an open front garment with extremely long closed sleeves - the arms protrude through a slit at the elbow. The ends of the sleeves are square and are further characterized by an arc of a circle appearing near the bottom. The Doctor's gown is also an open front garment, with round bell-shaped sleeves along the length of the arm. There are wide, black velvet panels facing down the front with three velvet bars on each sleeve, which may portray the color that represents the degree earned or may remain black.

It is in the design of the hood that is distinctly American. Simple, yet beautiful, each degree, Bachelor's, Master's and Doctor's, is represented by a distinct shape or form. The Bachelor's hood is the smallest of the three - the velvet edging is narrower and less exposed. The Master's hood is the same length as the Doctor's - the velvet edging is somewhat wider than the Bachelor's and more of the lining can be seen. The Doctor's hood is easily recognized by the width of the velvet edging, its wide panels and the full exposure of the lining. The lining of the hood indicates the colors of the institute conferring the degree and the color of the velvet trimmings represents the degree.

The black gowns, trimmed with multi-colored velvet and worn by some members of the Dental Faculty, indicate membership in the American College of Dentists or the International College of Dentists.

### **ACADEMIC PROCESSION & MACE**

The order of the Academic Procession (see page 2) is governed by academic protocol. College and School order of march is determined by their founding. Leading the Procession is the Grand Marshal. The Grand Marshal is the Master/Mistress of Ceremonies and Macebearer.

The mace is ceremonial and dates back to sixteenth century England where it was used as a formidable weapon to protect high ranking civil, educational and religious officials, and royalty. Today the mace has become a symbol of authority and is carried by a distinguished member of the academic community.

Attached to the silver crown of the mace is a double-sided University crest. Circumscribed around the consolidated institutions' crests is the wording, "University of Detroit Mercy." The left side of the inner circle portrays two wolves at a pot, symbolizing the generosity of the Loyola family (Ignatius Loyola was the founder of the Society of Jesus). After all the family and the workers were fed, even the wild animals had the pot to lick.

The motto of the Jesuits, "Ad Majorem Dei Gloriam" (For the Greater Glory of God), is located above the wolves and the pot. The date 1877 refers to the founding of University of Detroit by the Jesuits.

On the inner circle, right side, is a silver cross which is the symbol of the Religious Sisters of Mercy, who founded Mercy College of Detroit in 1941. The three canettes are taken from the coat of arms of the Archdiocese of Detroit, symbolizing the Archdiocese and the City. The open book is the traditional symbol for a college. Upon the open pages is inscribed Mercy College's motto, "Maria, Sedes Sapientiae" (Mary, Seat of Wisdom).

The shaft of the mace is made of silver and ebony.
