COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER



THE HONORABLE VICTORIA A. ROBERTS RETIRED JUDGE, UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT FOR THE EASTERN DISTRICT OF MICHIGAN

Retired Judge Victoria Roberts, a Past President of the State Bar of Michigan, served as a federal district court judge in the Eastern District of Michigan for 25 years before she retired on September 1, 2023. She is recognized as an international teacher and lecturer on behalf of the Federal Judicial Center, the State Department and the Department of Justice.

On the Court, she proposed and implemented the operation of a *Pro Se* Legal Assistance Clinic in conjunction with Detroit Mercy Law. It is housed in the Theodore Levin U.S. Courthouse. She also submitted a proposal to the bench to launch an Early Mediation Program for *Pro Se* Prisoner Civil Rights Cases. With nearly 50 volunteer mediators, the program launched June 2018.

Judge Roberts is the recipient of numerous awards, including the two highest conferred by the State Bar of Michigan. Judge Roberts received an honorary degree of Doctor of Laws from Northeastern University. She was named Michigan Lawyers Weekly "Woman of the Year" in 2013 and received the Detroit Metropolitan Bar Association Foundation Dennis W. Archer Public Service Award in 2012. In 1997, she was named one of the Lawyers of the Year by Michigan Lawyers Weekly. In 2023, the ACLU of Michigan honored her for her legacy of mentorship and service on the bench. Also in 2023, the American Board of Trial Advocates bestowed on her its Lifetime Judicial Achievement Award. In 2024, The Michigan Chronicle honored her as one of its Women of Excellence.

On the bench, Judge Roberts served on various committees and was a chief mediator in the City of Detroit Bankruptcy case.

She has served on the boards of several organizations, including Big Brothers Big Sisters; the Fair Housing Center of Metropolitan Detroit; St. Leo's Soup Kitchen; and the State Bar of Michigan Foundation. Under the auspices of the Wolverine Bar Association, which offers a scholarship in her name, Judge Roberts engineered two programs designed to increase minority representation in the legal profession.

Judge Roberts received her Juris Doctor in 1976 from Northeastern University School of Law. Her undergraduate degree, in journalism and sociology, is from the University of Michigan. She practiced law for 22 years before joining the bench. In December 2023, Judge Roberts joined JAMS as a neutral mediator and arbitrator.
