It is permissible to use screens, or tints, of these colors to enhance readability or for aesthetic reasons.

PRIMARY COLORS

Our primary colors are the most significant identifier. It must be present throughout all brand collateral but both colors do not always have to be included. Utilize the UDM Red or UDM Blue, even if it's a small amount, to help visually tie back to Detroit Mercy as a brand.

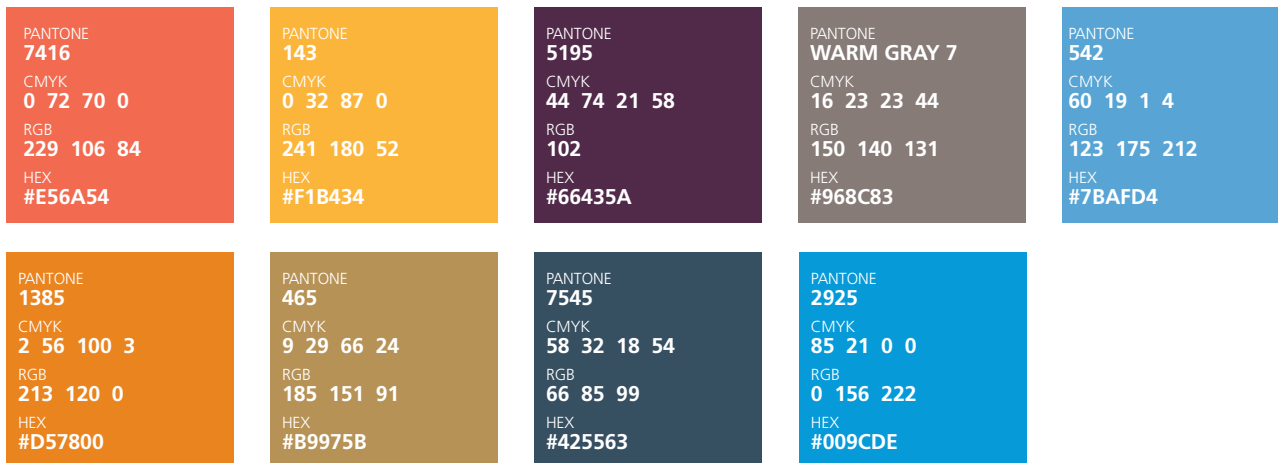
