

## MACOMB COMMUNITY COLLEGE TRANSFER GUIDE

## COLLEGE OF HEALTH PROFESSIONS HEALTHCARE OPERATIONS MANAGEMENT (HOM)

The following courses will transfer into Detroit Mercy's Healthcare Operations Management (HOM) program. Students may transfer a maximum of 63 credits toward a Bachelor's Degree; course grades must be a C or higher. If admitted under the MCC-Detroit Mercy HOM Articulation Agreement and completing an Associate Degree prior to transferring or within one year of transferring, students may transfer an additional 24 credits, for a total of 87 transferrable credits. Additional courses not on this guide may also transfer.
