Minimum 2.50 GPA based on 24 or more credits and successful completion of all required and prerequisite courses. All students (except RN's completing their BSN) are also required to take and pass the HESI with a composite score of 75. Students may transfer a maximum of 63 credits toward a Bachelor's Degree.
