ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum 2.0 GPA based on 24 or more credits earned at WCCCD.
- If less than 24 credits have been earned, a student's high school transcript is required.
- Students may transfer a maximum of 63 credits toward a Bachelor's Degree; course grades must be C or higher.
- If admitted under the WCCCD-UDM Health Services Administration Articulation Agreement, students may transfer an additional 15 credits, for a total of 78 transferable credits.
