- 2.) Read the Resident's Agreement and Sign.
- 3.) Fill out the **Residence Hall Application/Agreement** (pick up form at Shiple 115). Applications to the Peace and Social Justice community must be submitted to the Quad Complex Director with a Residence Hall Application/Agreement attached. If your Peace and Social Justice application is accepted your Residence Hall Application will be completed by the Quad Complex Director and turned into the Office of Residence Life (115 Shiple) following an interview with University Ministry and Residence Life.
- 4.) Answer the questions below thoroughly, as it will be reviewed carefully by Residence Life staff as well as University Ministry. Responses to each question must be 25 to 100 words, typed and double-spaced.
- 5.) After receiving the Peace and Social Justice application, representatives from Residence Life and University Ministry will interview all candidates for admission onto the floor.
- 6.) Due Dates for all application materials will be given by the Quad Complex Director and must be adhered to.

### PEACE AND SOCIAL JUSTICE APPLICATION QUESTIONS:

1. What does Peace and Social Justice mean to you? What are your reasons for wanting to join the Peace and Social Justice Floor community?
2. Service: In what capacities have you been involved in Service in the past?
  - a) Why do you want it to be a commitment in your life?
  - b) What types of service, related to the floor's focus on Social Justice, do you most look forward to?
3. Community: What about the floor community appeals to you?
  - a) How do you believe you will contribute to the floor's existing community?
  - b) Please list two concerns, you believe, may arise on the floor. How would you work through those concerns as a member of the floor?
4. Reflection: What have you done during the past year to promote your personal and spiritual development?
  - a) What hopes do you have for the further development of self as a member of 4 West?
  - b) What activities would you promote to help Four West develop and share their spirituality with one another?
5. Time is essential to participate in service, reflection, meals and community activities. How would you set aside time to be an active member of the Peace and Social Justice Floor.
  - a) What other obligations do you have that may compete or conflict with your participation in Four West?
  - b) How would you overcome those obstacles?
