Wayne State University will host the Istvan Danosi/Michigan Open, a day-long fencing tournament, starting at 8:30 a.m. Sunday at the Matthaei Building.

Fencers from Wayne State, Detroit Mercy, Michigan and Michigan State are scheduled to compete. Six individual titles will be contested — men's epee, sabre and foil, and women's epee, sabre and foil.

Returning to defend their titles are WSU seniors Marek Petraszek (epee) and Bobby Smith (sabre). Detroit's Craig Budzynski won the men's foil title in 2005.
