COLLEGE HOOPS: Kansas pulls away from Detroit

LAWRENCE, Kan. -- Julian Wright and Russell Robinson led a second-half charge Thursday night that enabled mistake-prone No. 9 Kansas to pull away late and beat the University of Detroit, 63-43.

The 25-point underdog Titans found themselves trailing only 41-37 when Jon Goode made a three-pointer with 8:55 to go, silencing a nervous crowd in Allen Fieldhouse, where the Jayhawks since 1994-95 are now 172-11.

Wright got the decisive 9-0 run going with two quick buckets and Robinson, after Wright rebounded a Detroit miss, hit a three-pointer that made it 50-37 with 6:02 to play.

Mario Chalmers led the Jayhawks (11-2) with 22 points.

Brandon Cotton had 20 for Detroit (3-9).

Big Ten women

NO. 21 MICHIGAN STATE 74, INDIANA 49: Rene Haynes scored 20 points, and 6-foot-9 freshman Allyssa DeHaan blocked nine shots, setting game and season records for the host Spartans (10-2) in their Big Ten opener. Haynes was 7-for-13 from the field and 5-for-5 from the line and also had eight rebounds, four assists and three steals. DeHaan, who has blocked 60 shots this season, finished with 10 points, all in the second half, and 10 rebounds. Nikki Smith and

Kim Roberson each had 12 points for the Hoosiers (11-3).

NO. 13 PURDUE 79, MICHIGAN 35: Katie Gearlds scored 22 points and broke the host Boilermakers' record for career three-pointers in the Big Ten opener for both teams. Gearlds was 5-of-9 from three-point range to push her career total to 186 for Purdue (12-2). Kelly Helvey led the Wolverines (7-7), who shot 24 percent and made 22 turnovers, with nine points.

Top 25 men

NO. 2 NORTH CAROLINA 87, RUTGERS 48: Brandan Wright had 19 points and seven rebounds, and fellow freshman Wayne Ellington added 17 points for the host Tar Heels (11-1). Adrian Hill scored 13 in leading the Scarlet Knights (6-6), who played without leading scorer J.R. Inman and fellow starter Anthony Farmer, who served one-game suspensions for academic reasons.

NO. 7 ARIZONA 94, CALIFORNIA 85: Marcus Williams scored 21 points and Ivan Radenovic 17 for the host Wildcats (10-1, 1-0 Pac-10). Williams made all eight of his shots from the floor, and Radenovic hit six of seven. Freshman Ryan Anderson led the Golden Bears (8-5, 0-1) with 16 points.

NO. 11 TEXAS A&M 101, GRAMBLING STATE 27: Josh Carter tied a school record with eight three-pointers for the host Aggies (11-2), who scored the first 28 points of the game and limited Grambling (2-5) to 19 percent shooting.
