

# University of Detroit athletic director 357 **Kinsman steps down after 25 years**

DETROIT (AP) — Brad Kinsman is stepping down after 25 years as Detroit's athletic director.

Kinsman's departure is effective at the end of the year, the school announced Friday.

During Kinsman's tenure as AD, the Titans won 28 conference championships in 10 different sports. The school also has added men's and women's soccer as well as women's tennis, golf and cross and country.

"It has been an honor and privilege to serve as the athletic director at this outstanding university," Kinsman said in a statement. "I have been blessed over the years to have been associated with a dedicated, talented staff and coaches, exemplary student-athletes and extremely generous and supportive alumni and friends of the university."

Kinsman, 59, was named athletic director Feb. 9, 1982, having served as interim AD for six months.
