

College expands dental clinic

DETROIT — The University of Detroit Mercy plans to expand its dental clinic to better serve thousands of people in need of affordable care as part of an \$80 million investment in the city. The School of Dentistry, counting classroom and clinic space, will more than double in size when it moves to a new location near downtown in 2008. About \$30 million will be invested in relocating the dental school. "It's an opportunity to take something that has to be done and turn it into a great future," the Rev. Gerard Stockhausen, University of Detroit Mercy president said. The rest of the money will be spent on renovation and construction at the private Catholic university's other two campuses.
