ASHLAND, Ohio — George Richard (Dick) Dus Sault, 83, of Ashland, formerly of Monroe County, died Sept. 15 at Brethren Care Village.

Services were held Sept. 30 at Christ United Methodist Church. The Rev. James Cox officiated. Private burial was in Ashland County Memorial Park. Denbow-Primm-Kemery Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.
