He served in as a forward observer in the Marine Corps during the Korean War.

Mr. Brasher was a member of Veterans of Foreign Wars, American Legion, Loyal Order of the Moose, Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks and Whiskey Creek Country Club of Fort Myers. He earned a bachelor's degree from Michigan State University, East Lansing, and a master's degree from the University of Detroit. He moved from Monroe to Fort Myers in 1986. He also had lived in Muskegon Heights and enjoyed golfing.

Surviving are his wife; two sons, Alan and John; a sister, Roberta Crisher, and a grandson.
