Investiture planned for Judge Szymanski

5 Frank S. Szymanski has been elected to serve as a judge of the Wayne County Probate Court and will serve in the Third Judicial Circuit of Michigan – Juvenile Division filling the seat vacated by Wayne County Probate Court Judge James E. Lacey.

“We are fortunate to have an individual of Frank Szymanski’s professional experience, educational background, and community involvement elected to serve as a probate judge, as he will be a great asset to our court,” Wayne County Probate Court Chief Judge Milton L. Mack Jr. said.

Szymanski has practiced law for more than 25 years specializing in probate. He has been appointed as a Probate Court mediator and has served as a special fiduciary appointed by the probate judges based on his extensive experience. He served as president of the Wayne County Probate Bar Association and instituted the Probate Bar Referral Service.

Szymanski graduated from the University of Detroit Mercy School of Law.
