## Today's games

### WISCONSIN-MILWAUKEE AT DETROIT MERCY

**Matchup:** Detroit Mercy 6-12, 3-4 Horizon League; Wisconsin-Milwaukee 7-14, 4-4.

**Tip-off:** 7 p.m., Calihan Hall.

**Radio:** WDTW-AM (1310).

**Line:** UDM by 4.

**Overview:** Tonight's game is the first of three the Titans will play in five days. They host No. 14 Butler on Saturday and travel to Chicago State on Monday. Detroit's next win will be the 250th of Perry Watson's college career.

### WAYNE STATE AT GRAND VALLEY STATE

**Matchup:** Wayne State 8-8, 4-4 Great Lakes; Grand Valley State 16-2, 7-2.

**Tip-off:** 8, GVSU Fieldhouse Arena, Allendale.

**TV/radio:** Comcast Local; WDTK-AM (1400).

**Overview:** The Lakers are on a 10-game winning streak and have limited teams to 52 points or fewer in each of the past seven. In the latest NCAA Division II statistics, the Lakers were leading the nation in scoring defense (52.1 points) and field-goal defense (36.2%). Grand Valley junior guard Jason Jamerson averages 14.5 points and 5.1 rebounds.

### OAKLAND AT ORAL ROBERTS

**Matchup:** Oakland University 12-9, 5-0 Mid-Continent; Oral Roberts 13-7, 5-0.

**Tip-off:** 8, Mabee Center, Tulsa, Okla.

**Radio:** None.

**Overview:** Oakland's 5-0 conference record is its best since joining the Mid-Continent in 1998. The Golden Grizzlies are riding a four-game winning

streak, and their 12 overall victories have exceeded last season's total of 11.

## Women

### NO. 23 MSU AT PENN STATE

**Matchup:** Penn State 9-11, 2-5 Big Ten; Michigan State 15-4, 6-1.

**Tip-off:** 6, Bryce Jordan Center, State College, Pa.

**TV/radio:** None.

**Overview:** The Spartans have never won at Penn State. The Nittany Lions have a balanced scoring attack; four players average between 11.8 and 13.5 points. Senior guard Victoria Lucas-Perry (14.1 points) leads MSU, and freshman center Allysa DeHaan adds 12.9 points and 8.6 rebounds. MSU is first in the conference in rebound margin (+7.6), third in offense (67.1 points), third in scoring margin (+11.6 points) and second in team defense (55.6 points).

### MICHIGAN AT WISCONSIN

**Matchup:** Wisconsin 14-6, 3-4 Big Ten; Michigan 8-12, 1-6.

**Tip-off:** 8, Kohl Center, Madison, Wis.

**TV/radio:** WTKA-AM (1050).

**Overview:** Besides its lone Big Ten victory, U-M's 62-59 loss to Wisconsin in Ann Arbor was its best conference performance this season. Junior guard Jolene Anderson shot only 4-for-15 against U-M but led Wisconsin with 15 points in the Jan. 11 game. In conference games, U-M is last in offense (51.0 points), last in field-goal percentage (31.6%), 10th in three-point percentage (23.8%) and 10th in scoring margin (-13.9 points).
