The Raiders (16-8, 9-2 Horizon League) completed a season sweep of the Titans with their fourth consecutive victory and remained a game behind conference leader Butler.

Brandon Cotton had 14 points and Brandon Bell scored 12 for Detroit (9-14, 5-6).

Bell made a three-pointer to cut Wright State's lead to 53-47 with 3:34 to

play, but Drew Burleson answered with a three-point play 20 seconds later. His lay-up ended the Raiders' seven-minute field-goal drought.

Detroit, which trailed the entire game, was 1-for-10 from the floor during a six-minute stretch of the first half, during which the Raiders went on an 11-2 run and took their first double-digit lead.
