### St. John Detroit Riverview Campus to Maintain Emergency Department, Physician Offices and Support Services Onsite

DETROIT, June 22 *PRNewswire-USNewswire* — St. John Health is maintaining an Emergency Department, physician practices in the Medical Pavilions and pharmacy, X-ray and laboratory services at the Detroit Riverview Center, after the hospital discontinues inpatient care on June 30, 2007.

"St. John Health remains committed to providing what the residents of Detroit need most — access to primary care physicians, community health programs and emergency care services," said Joe Tasse, president, St. John Detroit Riverview Hospital. "These services will remain onsite at the Detroit Riverview Center during the Karmanos renovation and we're

exploring moving them nearby, once Karmanos moves into the facility."

St. John Detroit Riverview physicians will remain on the Detroit Riverview campus in Medical Pavilions I and II for approximately one year. Physician specialties include internal medicine, pediatrics, OB/GYN, maternal fetal medicine, endocrinology, orthopedics, physiatry, general surgery, vascular, podiatry, cardiology, nephrology, and ophthalmology. The University of Detroit Mercy Dental School clinic also will continue to offer services. During this time, patients can continue regularly scheduled or new appointments, by calling their physician office directly or St. John Health Connect at 888-440-7325. Transportation services that bring patients to and from the Medical Pavilions will continue during this time.

St. John Health will maintain emergency services at the Detroit Riverview campus, 24 hours a day, seven days a week. To support the patient care needs of the physicians and Emergency Department, outpatient pharmacy, laboratory and diagnostic imaging services will be offered on the campus.

In addition, St. John Health continues to serve the residents of Detroit through its Community Health initiatives, which include six health clinics, 13 school-based health centers (12 in the city of Detroit), and more than 100 parish nursing programs.
