Davis joins Dr. Paganini's dental practice

Dr. Robert John Davis of suburban Detroit recently joined Dr. Paganini's dental practice at 1080 S. Van Dyke.

Davis graduated from University of Michigan B.A., and Detroit College of Law J.D. and University of Detroit Mercy D.D.S. He recently worked in Grand Rapids and Flint area.

"Patients and people of the town seem very warm and friendly," Davis said about his new location.

Davis said he decided to become a doctor because he feels "healing patients was the highest calling one could dedicate oneself to."
