You've been to Cedar Point, the lake, Up North and to a concert or two and now Labor Day is closing in. What's left to do? Here are a few suggestions for shows with a twist that will be wrapping up soon:

### ICONIC ART

What: Andy Warhol's Dream America: Screenprints from the Collection of the Jordan Schnitzer Family Foundation

Where: Toledo Museum of Art, 2445 Monroe St., Toledo

When: Through Sept. 9. Museum hours, 10 a.m.-4 p.m. Tuesdays through Thursdays and Saturdays, 10 a.m.-10 p.m. Fridays, 11 a.m.-5 p.m. Sundays.

How much: Free.

Details: More than 100 works, many in rarely seen, complete portfolios, that span the artist's career, including the 1967 Marilyn Monroe portfolio, the 1986 Cowboys and Indians portfolio and his Campbell's Soup cans. Several individual works, including self-portraits, also are on display.

Warhol, a pop culture icon, is called one of the most influential American artists of the 20th century.

"Andy Warhol revolutionized both artmaking and the persona of the artist," said Dr. Amy Gilman, TMA associate curator of modern and contemporary art. "He changed what had been historically appropriate for art objects and used mass production techniques in unprecedented ways."

How much: One round, \$5 for adults, \$4 for DIA members, \$3 for children 12 and younger.

Details: A 10-hole mini golf course specially designed for the DIA by Detroit area artists, architects and designers is located on the north lawn while the museum is closed to complete its renovation.
