Fisher was formerly an adjunct instructor at the school. He also has taught at the Florida Institute of Technology and holds a business degree from Michigan State University.

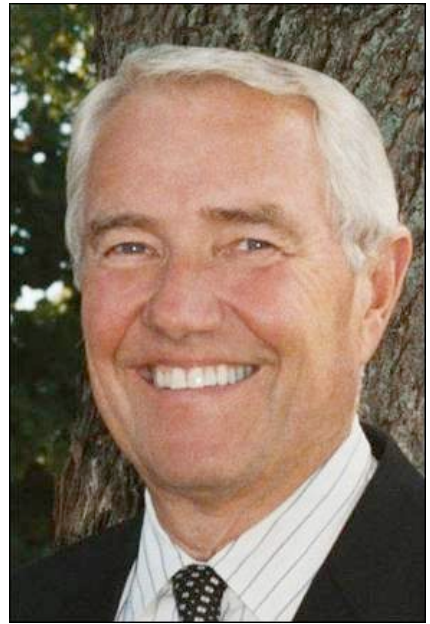
