1. LAWYERS WILL RIDE INTO BATTLE CREEK TO HELP MILITARY VETERANS

BATTLE CREEK(AP) – A law office on wheels from the University of Detroit Mercy will roll into Battle Creek on Tuesday to offer free legal help to veterans. “We focus on providing legal assistance to veterans who are of lower income and are having trouble with disability benefits,” Anita Scott-Meisel, an attorney with the Mobile Law Office, said. The university is being paid \$200,000 by the state to provide the clinics. Scott-Meisel said the program is expanding across the state, to include Grand Rapids, Lansing, Flint and Traverse City. Other stops planned this year are Benton Harbor, Muskegon and Pontiac.
