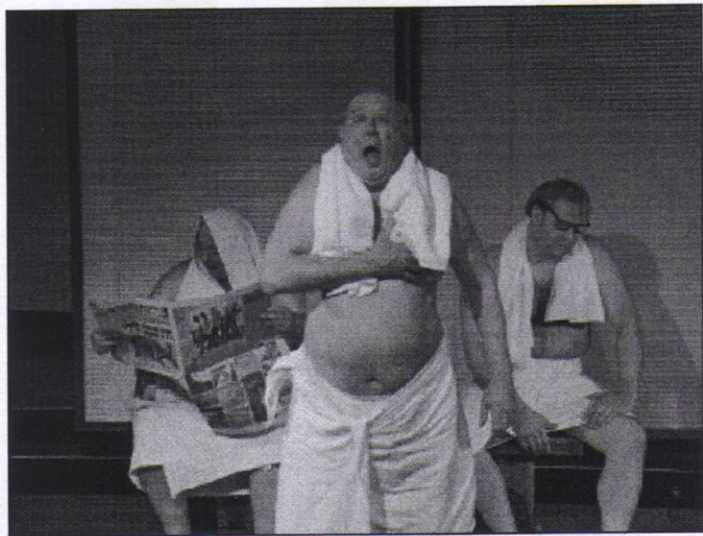
"OY!" is a ball. The cast is
