Policy

Academic Computing labs may be reserved by faculty on a first-come first-served basis for teaching of University of Detroit Mercy official courses listed in the current course schedule.

In the event a class session is canceled, the faculty member must notify the lab prior to the start of the session.

In labs where courses are taught, the scheduled class reservation takes precedence over all other usage of the lab. Students using systems prior to the start of a scheduled class are obligated to leave ten minutes prior to the start of the class.

Reservations by students for individual computers in Academic Computing Labs are not taken nor allowed. Use of computers during open times is available on a first-come first-served basis.
