Pink Zoning Detroit, now called MIX TAPE, is a research project for the City of Detroit's Planning and Development Department that targets three commercial corridors in the city for investigation. Laavu was selected to interrogate the existing zoning ordinances and existing conditions in order to envision radically new conditions for these disinvested sites. These designs are being tested against the City's existing codes and approval processes to identify how regulatory strategies and municipal processes might be restructured to make redevelopment more successful.

Gold Cash Gold restaurant opened in a rehabilitated pawnshop in the Corktown neighborhood of Detroit. White-washed brick walls offset the stained glass details and reclaimed lath ceiling. The restaurant features an open kitchen, 65 seat dining area, a full bar and outdoor patio.
