The Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program has 6 learning outcomes. One outcome is evaluated yearly. Faculty assess learning outcomes using signature assignments in theory courses, as well as clinical competencies measured with the clinical evaluation tool. Data is collected from instructors who teach the courses via the End of the Semester Course Reports submitted to administration. Any recommendations for change based on assessment feedback are provided to the Undergraduate Faculty by the Curriculum and Outcomes committees for decision making specific to program improvements.

4. Student Learning Outcomes -Which student learning outcome(s) from the assessment plan filed with the University Assessment Team is/are being reported on in this report? Include the corresponding benchmark(s) for each outcome.

Referencing the Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program Assessment Plan on file with the University Team, student learning outcome #1 was assessed. Outcome 1: Provide compassionate care with a commitment to social justice. Students demonstrate this outcome in their clinical immersion course and are evaluated by the Clinical Evaluation Tool. The benchmark for success is that 85% of students meet the objectives specific to Outcome #1 in their clinical area. Additionally, the outcome is measured in 3 theory courses. The assignments include: a final group presentation specific to service learning in the Intro to Nursing course, a Cultural Heritage Assessment assignment in the Population Health course, as well as a Research Ethics Assignment. The benchmark for success is 85% of students pass those signature assignments achieving a C or better.

7. **Results, Planned Actions, and/or Actions Taken** -Briefly summarize the assessment results, how they relate to benchmark(s), and how you are using them to enhance student learning and improve program quality.

The benchmarks were exceeded for the learning outcome, with 100% of students meeting the clinical competencies for Outcome #1. Additionally, 100% of students achieved a C or better on theory signature assignments in all 3 didactic courses. Although the benchmark was exceeded, the department acknowledges the need to revise signature assignments to increase rigor and improve program quality. A draft of newly proposed assignments has been uploaded with this report. The proposed assignments will be reviewed and voted on by faculty during the Winter 2024 semester. New benchmarks will be established.
