Registration for both Summer and Fall 2023 are ongoing.

- Reach out to those who have not registered yet and refer to applicable support offices if needed (Financial Aid, Student Accounting, Student Success Center, etc.).
- Demonstrate how to view "Meeting Times" column in the Class Schedule to see course days/time and final exam days/times. This is often a point of confusion for students.
- There are now [48 Summer discounted courses](#) available at \$333 per credit. Encourage students to take summer classes and remind them that GPA does not transfer in from other institutions, only credits.

Students Requesting Transfer credit/classes at other institutions

- Remind students to use the internal form: [Current Detroit Mercy Student: Request for Guest/Transfer Credit](#) on the Registrar webpage. Check with guest institution to follow their policy for incoming guest students.
- Senior Residency Rule: Candidates for a bachelor's degree are to complete the last 30 credit hours of their program at University of Detroit Mercy. Any exceptions must be approved by the student's Dean's office.
- Students needs a "C" or better to transfer classes.
- If students take guest class(es) at another institution they will need to order a copy of their transcripts to be sent to the Office of the Registrar.

Transfer Credit Limits Apply

- ✓ Maximum 63 credits from community colleges (if a student has more, the most relevant credits will be used). Additional credits may transfer for Articulation Agreements.
- ✓ Maximum 90-96 total transfer credits from 4-year universities (varies based on program).
