Advising/Registration continues for Winter 2024 and Summer 2024

Submitting Final Grades at end of Fall Term

All grades are due on **December 18 at Noon**. End of term processing such as academic status, degree certification, financial aid review, etc. cannot be completed until ALL grades are submitted.

Fall 2023/Winter 2024/Summer 2024 Graduates

Students who graduate from Detroit Mercy in December 2023 will receive their diplomas in January from their college/school. There is only one Commencement ceremony annually in May. Fall 2023/Winter 2024/Summer 2024 graduates will be invited to the May 11, 2024 Commencement. Students planning to graduate between now and August 2024 should apply for graduation ASAP on-line in their Student Profile page (left side menu).

Rules for Maintaining F-1 Visa or F1 Status for International Students

In order for international students to maintain F-1 Visa or F1 status, ensure that they are taking the required number of face-to-face credit hours.

Undergraduate students must enroll in a minimum of 9 F2F credits as part of their full-time load. Graduate students must enroll in a minimum of 6 F2F credits as part of their full-time load.

Note: Courses that meet at least 50% in person (i.e. 100% in-person, Hybrid 1, or Hybrid 3) are considered face-to-face courses. OL1, OL2, Hybrid 2 courses are consider online courses.
