## Create Advising Plans for Your Incoming Students

Advising plans can be created at [my.udmercy.edu](http://my.udmercy.edu): Faculty Self-Service: Advisor Management. Search for your advisee. Go to "Registration and Planning" on their student profile. Click on "Plan Ahead". The Office of the Registrar will remove all advising holds each Friday morning of SOAR.

**New freshmen cannot register prior to this or they will be withdrawn.**

## Advising New Students (freshmen and transfers)

Make sure they register for the appropriate ENL and MTH courses, if needed. Delayed degree dates are occurring when students put these off due to prerequisites. Note: Restrictions exist on retaking ALEKS-Math after the first week of class/registration. ## Placement Testing

If available, students will be placed into classes by ACT/SAT scores. Students who do not have ACT/SAT scores and/or do not have AP/IB/dual-enrollment credits in relevant subjects, must take placement test(s). If students need to take a placement test, they may do so by logging into the "Placement Testing 2025-2026" course shell listed on Blackboard. Test scores and placements can be viewed in the Student's Profile under "Prior Education and Testing." ## Advanced Placement (AP) & International Baccalaureate (IB)

AP scores from exams taken in 2022-2024 which have arrived have been processed. 2025 AP scores will arrive in July and credits will be posted ASAP. If not already done, please have your advisee request that College Board release their official AP scores to Detroit Mercy. IB transcripts arrive in July and will be processed ASAP. ## Dual-Enrollment and Transfer Credit

The Transfer Team will post dual-enrollment transfer credits upon receipt of an official transcript. If the credit has not yet been posted, contact the Transfer Team ([transferteam@udmercy.edu](mailto:transferteam@udmercy.edu) or 313-993-1940) or have the student request an official transcript be sent to [registrar@udmercy.edu](mailto:registrar@udmercy.edu) for processing.
