Midterm Grades Significance

Midterm grades are an essential component of students' progress in their current classes. Faculty must submit all midterm grades by the deadline to ensure consistency with university policy. Advisors should check student's midterm grades when advising. F grades should indicate a student has been attending class but is not passing the course. However, an XF grade is assigned when a student has *never* attended and should include the first date of the course as the Last Date of Attendance. "I" grades should not be reported as midterm grades.
