Senior Residency Rule: Candidates for a bachelor's degree are to complete the last 30 credit hours of their program at University of Detroit Mercy. Any exception to this rule must be approved by the student's dean's office.

Transfer Credit Limits:

Max 63 credits from community colleges (if a student has more, the most relevant credits will be used). Additional credits may transfer if Articulation Agreement exists.

Max 90-96 *total* transfer credits from 4-year universities. (Varies based on program because students must complete at least 30 credits in residence at Detroit Mercy.)
