### Reviewing students planning to graduate Fall 2021

Advisees who plan to graduate in **Fall 2021** may need an accurate advisor's note documenting successful degree completion depending on their program. The **Degree Evaluation (DE)** is the perfect tool to use for auditing the academic record and graduation planning. Please review your advisees **DE** to ensure they are on track to graduate. This includes all requirements needed for degree and certificate completion.

### Did your advisee take summer classes at another institution?

Students who took summer classes elsewhere are responsible for ensuring courses are transferred to Detroit Mercy. Please remind students to have **official** transcripts sent to the transfer team [transferteam@udmercy.edu](mailto:transferteam@udmercy.edu)

### Does your advisee have a profile picture?

If your advisee does not have a picture on their profile, please remind them to have their picture ID taken and get their parking pass/permit. ID Location and times for fall term are as follows:
