GEARING UP FOR SOAR 2022!

Student Orientation, Advising & Registration will be in-person this year on June 16th, 23rd and July 14th and 15th! Students should contact admission counselors to select and reserve their preferred SOAR dates. In-person SOAR will be one-day events and all programming and registration will take place on that same day. Academic advising may be done in advance. Contact your Assistant/Associate Deans about how your college will coordinate advising before students visit for registration. CREATE YOUR PLANS AND RELEASE ADVISING HOLDS:

Advising plans can be created at my.udmercy.edu > Faculty Self-Service: Advisor Management. Search for your advisee. Go to "Registration and Planning" on their student profile. Click on "Plan Ahead".

*Be sure to leave an advisor note, but PLEASE DO NOT REMOVE THE ADVISING HOLD FOR NEW FRESHMEN. Registrar's Office will remove advising holds the morning of SOAR.

**Be sure to click on Instructor/Meeting Times in Class Details to see if a class is in-person, hybrid, 100% online, etc.

PLACEMENT TESTING

If available, students will be placed into classes by ACT/SAT scores. Students who do not have ACT/SAT scores and/or do not have AP/IB/Dual enrollment credits in the relevant subjects, **MUST take placement tests.** If students need to or elect to take a placement test, they may do so by logging into the "Placement Testing 2022-2023" course shell listed on Blackboard. ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) & INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB)

AP scores taken in 2021 (and earlier) which have arrived to us will be processed by June 1. AP scores from 2022 will arrive in July and credit will be posted ASAP. If not already requested, please have your advisee request that College Board mail an official AP Score Report to Detroit Mercy (code 1835). IB transcripts arrive in mid-to-late July and will be processed ASAP. Students may contact IB at ibo.org to have an official IB transcript mailed to Detroit Mercy. DUAL-ENROLLMENT TRANSFER CREDIT

The Transfer Team will post dual-enrollment credits upon receipt of an official transcript to our team.
