Using Mid-Term Grades in Advising

Mid-term grades can be a valuable tool for not only students but also for faculty advisors in order to review progress towards degree completion. Students can be advised to talk to an instructor to see if there are options for improving their grade, can be referred to the Student Success Center for assistance or should consider withdrawing.

The Last Date to Withdraw for the full semester courses for Winter 2017 is March 30th. Shorter duration courses will have a different withdraw date. Check the Schedule of Classes for the exact Date to Withdraw which is listed on each course section.

Identifying Core Classes in the Schedule of Classes

In the Fall 2017 Schedule of Classes there are notations on each class section offered that meets an Old Core requirement or a New Core requirement. Search features can be used for old or new core classes depending on which core is applicable. New transfer students for Fall 2017 will have the option of choosing the old core or the new core depending on what is in their best interest. New degree evaluations in Titan Connect for the new core are currently under development. Students entering the University prior to Fall 2017 will follow the old core.

Discounted Summer 2017 Classes

The university is offering a number of undergraduate sections during the summer at a discounted rate of \$333 per credit. These courses can be used to catch up, make-up or get ahead in progress towards a student's degree program.
