Placement Testing

- All incoming SOAR students will be tested for English and Math. Depending on their program and high school record, some will be tested for Chemistry and Languages. Placement scores will be posted in your self-service, student screen called "**View Test Scores.**"
- If a student is displeased with their placement test scores, please send them to the Student Success Center or call Susan Trudeau at x3383. Note, students must wait one week before retaking a placement test and there is a \$15.00 per test fee.

Athletes

If a student is an athlete, the student must be registered for **UAS 1070**.

ACT/SAT

Did you know that Michigan is moving to the new redesigned SAT test? Some students may still have ACT during the transition. Some may have both.

Advanced Placement (AP)

- 2016 AP scores will arrive in July; credits will be posted ASAP. Earlier scores have been posted.
- If we are missing AP scores, please have your advisee contact College Board to request an official AP score report be sent to UDM (**code 1835**). See contact info at left.

International Baccalaureate (IB)

- If the Transfer Team has already received an IB transcript, credit may be posted.
- If the student believes we are missing IB credits, please have him/her contact IB at ibo.org to have an official IB transcript sent to UDM.

Dual-Enrollment Transfer Credit

- If the student was dual-enrolled at a college or university during high school, the Transfer Team has posted the credit if we received the transcript.
- If the credit has not yet been posted, contact the Transfer Team (x1940) or have the student request an official transcript sent to: UDM Office of the Registrar, 4001 West McNichols Rd., Detroit, MI 48221-3038 or sent electronically to registrar@udmercy.edu.

Fall 2016 schedule changes -

If credits from the above sources are received after a student has registered and the addition of credits requires a schedule change, the student, advisor and/or dean's office will be contacted.
