Leadership Minor Advising – Biology 7-year Dental 3.8.26

Two notes:

1. Work with your advisor to see how transfer or AP/IB credits can help you out.
2. We recommend you take the introductory course as soon as you can. Usually, a core course can be delayed and taken a little later in your undergraduate program.
3. We recommend core courses so that the Leadership Minor does not add classes to your already packed schedule. This is called “double-dipping” and we use it a lot. Some courses can be counted in your major and minor or the university core and your minor. In fact, LEAD 2000 is a “triple-dipper”—counting for the minor, IT5, and IT6. If you follow the sheet carefully and speak with your Advisor and/or Associate Deans, the only “extra” course you should need to fulfill the minor is the Leadership Capstone. No course can count twice within the four skill areas listed on the left.
4. It is so important for 7-yr. Dental folks to select wisely so they aren't adding courses!

Community Engagement Skills	Take one of these: AAS 2000 – Critical Perspectives in African-American Studies [IT4] AAS 3100 – Science, Technology and Race [IT4] HOM 3300 – Health in the Community [IT3] RELS 3400 – Class, Race, and Gender [D3] WGS 2000 – Gender, Sex, and Justice [IT4] <i>(BIO 4990 will still count in this category if you started at Detroit Mercy before F'25. I not, just be really smart about your choices for your IT3, IT4 and D3 core courses)</i>
