#### **ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS**

- Generally, a 3.0 GPA at Ferris State University (and/or other accredited institutions) is necessary for admission.
   We encourage you to meet with a Detroit Mercy School of Architecture administrator to discuss individual curriculum plans.
- If less than 24 credits have been earned, a student's high school transcript is required.
