COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING AND SCIENCE ENGINEERING PROGRAMS — NEW CORE

This guide includes the New Core Curriculum effective Fall 2017. Transfer students starting at Detroit Mercy between Fall 2017 and Summer 2021 will have the option to select this New Core or the Old Core. See Transfer Guides indicating "OLD CORE" for prior Core requirements.

The following courses will transfer into Detroit Mercy's Engineering programs (Architectural, Civil, Electrical, Mechanical, or Robotics & Mechatronic Systems). Students may transfer up to 63 credits towards a Bachelor's Degree. If admitted under the Monroe CCC-University of Detroit Mercy Articulation Agreement, students may transfer additional MCCC courses that apply toward their Detroit Mercy engineering degree (currently up to 64 Detroit Mercy credits – varies by program).
