

This guide reflects the New Core Curriculum effective Fall 2017. Transfer students starting at Detroit Mercy between Fall 2017 and Summer 2021 will have the option to select this New Core or the Old Core. See Transfer Guides indicating “OLD CORE” for prior Core requirements.

The following courses will transfer into Detroit Mercy’s Health Information Management and Technology program. Students may transfer a maximum of 63 credits toward a Bachelor’s Degree; course grades must be a C or better. If admitted under the St. Clair County CC - University of Detroit Mercy Health Information Management and Technology Articulation Agreement, students may transfer additional St. Clair County CC courses that apply toward their degree totaling up to 87 credits; varying by focus.
