Gary Peters U.S. Senator

U.S. Senator Gary Peters has been honored to represent the State of Michigan in the U.S. Senate since 2015.

Gary is Ranking Member of the Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs Committee, which is the Senate's top oversight committee. He also serves on the Appropriations Committee, which is responsible for crafting legislation that allocates federal resources, the Armed Services

Committee, and the Commerce, Science, and Transportation Committee, where he is also Ranking Member of the Surface Transportation, Freight, Pipelines, and Safety Subcommittee.

While working full-time, Gary earned an M.B.A. in Finance from the University of Detroit Mercy, an M.A. in political science from Wayne State University, an M.A. in Philosophy from Michigan State University with a focus on the ethics of development, and a J.D. from Wayne State University Law School.

Gary volunteered for the U.S. Navy Reserve at age 34, where he earned a Seabee Combat Warfare Specialist designation and rose to the rank of Lieutenant Commander. After the September 11th terrorist attacks on our country, he volunteered again for drilling status and served overseas as part of his Reserve duty. He later earned a diploma from the College of Naval Command and Staff, U.S. Naval War College.

Prior to his career in public service, Gary worked in the private sector for over 20 years as both a financial advisor and in a variety of management positions with two major financial service firms. He was an assistant vice president at Merrill Lynch before working at UBS/PaineWebber as a vice president.

Gary is known as one of the most effective and bipartisan U.S. Senators. For a third straight Congress, Gary was recognized as the most effective Senator by the non-partisan Center for Effective Lawmaking. He was also named by the non-partisan Lugar Center as the 2nd-most bipartisan Senator – and the most bipartisan Democrat – for his work during the 117th Congress.

Gary is a fifth-generation Michigander and has lived in Michigan his entire life. He and his wife, Colleen, live in Oakland County and have three children. They also recently became proud grandparents.
