Student Program Board Phenomenal Woman Award

Three categories for the Student Program Board Phenomenal Woman Award

- Senor Phenomenal Woman Award
 - Complete 95 credits by 8/30/16
- Underclass Phenomenal Woman Award
 - Completed 94 credits or less; by 8/30/16
- First Gen Phenomenal Woman Award – only students that have identified, as a first generation student are eligible for this award. * must be registered as a first generation student

Student Award Recipient Criteria

- Recipients must be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate program at the University of Detroit Mercy.
- Recipients will be selected on the basis of scholastic achievements (2.5 G.P.A. minimum) and an application process.
- Only full-time students will be considered.
- This is **NOT** an Academic Award.
- Active campus life participant and/or student leader
- Student leader as a member of a student organization, fraternity, sorority, student leader, resident advisor, athletic, sport club, and active on campus for a minimum of **1 year**.
- **Each recipient receives \$150 fiscal award, presented at the annual dinner.**
