Department of Public Safety Patrol

University of Detroit Mercy Public Safety Department has many of the same duties and responsibilities as your municipal police force, in addition to campus arrest authority.

Public safety is responsible for enforcing laws of the state and local ordinances on property owned by Detroit Mercy.

If an individual breaks the law, we may arrest them. Since we also enforce parking laws on campus, individuals parking or driving in violation may be ticketed.

ESCORTS — Can't use the buddy system? Call 313-993-1234 for an officer to accompany you to a parking lot or nearby location. Escort service is available to students and employees during the evening hours.
